#### Use of Camp Samac

- Campers should use the Conlin Rd. entrance to Samac for camping, program, events and activities (Please note the Simcoe Street entrance is only for access to the Store and Wardens office).
- Upon arrival youth should be met in the parking lot by the adult in charge (as per the booking request) and should be directed by the adult in charge to the correct site/building.
- Each building/camp site may have one vehicle on site for emergency purposes. No other vehicles are permitted beyond the main parking area. Vehicles are not to travel on the roadways between the hours of 6 pm Friday evening to 1pm on Sunday unless prior authorization has been secured through the camp Warden/Ranger.
- Vehicles are not permitted on the grass at any time as this may result in damage to septic tanks and drainage beds.
- The cutting of trees/vegetation is strictly prohibited and will result in additional fees.
- Groups shall not infringe on other users of the camp and their rented area.
- All groups are required to review the Check In/Out procedures and contact the Warden/Ranger if clarification is required. See web site.
- Any damage to buildings or property will be reported immediately to the Warden/Ranger.
- Groups will be invoiced for the cost of repairs/damages caused by the group.
- All fires must be in compliance with the standards set out by the Fire Inspection Office, please see "Requirements for Fires at Samac" document.
- Use of profanity or inappropriate language may result in the individual and/or group being asked to leave the camp.

Requirements for Fires at Samac

-All fires must be in the metal fire rings at their current locations. The pit area will be encircled with gravel and logs or benches for sitting. Benches must remain in place and not moved closer to the fire.

-Fires shall not exceed 12” (30.5 cm) above the ring.

-No combustible material stored within the identified boundary.

-Each fire pit area to have a shovel and pail of water at hand. (Supplied by Samac)

-All firewood must be supplied by Samac). This City requirement is to prevent the introduction of wood to the camp which may contain invasive species.

**NOTE:** It is imperative that these procedures are followed for fires at Samac as the camp could lose the permit for open fires issued by the City.

Charges for Non Compliance

- Extra cleaning required by the Warden/Ranger after Check out \$100.00
- Failure to comply with requirements for fire \$100.00
- Cutting of trees or vegetation \$150.00
- Damages to buildings or property Price set by outside contractor.
